



PTO Meeting – Minutes October 7, 2009

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm

1. We have filled all of the board positions. Tara will be secretary and Naomi and Sara Kilburn as Co-VP's.
2. Fundraiser – Although we did not meet our school goal of \$50,000, our preliminary count shows us at \$44,000. We do have a few issues that we need to resolve with the bank and then we will have a better count. November 4th will be the delivery date and the pig races and limo ride will take place on November 13th. We will need some volunteers to help us out with the limo ride.
3. Spaghetti Dinner/Bingo Night – We made \$340.00. We will need 20 pounds of spaghetti for next year. Soda, candy and chips were purchased and can be used for upcoming events.
4. Trick or Treat Street – We need help in the haunted hallways or we won't be able to do it. The price wasn't listed on the flyers that went home so we need to get the word out that there is a charge this year and a percent of the proceeds will be donated to Cub's Closet. Volunteers and their families will be free. The haunted hallways will be upstairs to help relieve some of the congestion. The games will be in the gym and food in the cafeteria. Click or Treat will be in the music room. Payment will be due for the pictures at that time and proceeds will be given to the library. The candy collecting contest begins the week of Oct. 12th and the classroom that collects the most will be given a pizza party. Set up will begin at 12:00 on October 24th.
5. Skate City Party – Will take place on November 5th. The bus will leave the school at 4:30 and will drop the kids back off at the school at 7:45pm. There is a school contest that if we have 3 parties or if we have the highest percentage of participation our school name will go into a drawing for \$500.
6. Treasurer's Report – We are at \$19,392.82. This number will change once the fundraiser is worked out with the bank. We raised \$136 from the Domino's Dough night. We will continue with keeping a balance of \$5,000 in the bank.
7. Santa Shop – We will need 3-5 volunteers. The dates are December 2, 3 and 4th from 3:00-4:30. The gifts will come from ABC Fundraising and the items will range from \$.50-\$10.00. Naomi volunteered to be in charge and it will be set up in the cafeteria.
8. Mrs. Ortega made a request that we consider providing at least one meal for the conferences. It was agreed upon.
9. Joan Kniss – spoke with regards to her school board re-election.
10. Any ideas to getting more parents involved in the PTO. Some suggestions were: Hand out flyers directly to parents in parking lot, Donuts for dads and muffins for moms, handing out coffee and a flyer and personally inviting parents in the parking lot, T-shirts that say PTO Mom or PTO Dad
